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NOTIFICATION

Whereas in notification No. FEE 211 FWL 1998 Dated 27-06-2001 published in Part 4A of the Karnataka Gazette dated 06-09-2001 the Government of Karnataka in exercise of powers conferred under subsection 04 of Section 35 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 (Central Act 53 of 1972)

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declared an area of 870.36 Sq.Km. in the districts of Chamarajanagar and Mysore as Bandipur National Park.

The National Tiger Conservation Authority vide the powers conferred on it by the Wild life (Protection) Amendment Act, 2006 (39 of 2006) under Section 38 V had directed the State Governments to delineate the Buffer/Peripheral areas of the Core or Critical Tiger Habitat and notify as the Buffer Zone vide its letter No. PS-MS(NTCA)2007-Miscle Dated 16-11-2007.

The indicative Tiger Conservation Plan for the Bandipur Tiger Reserve was submitted to the National Tiger Conservation Authority by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wild life), Bangalore vide his letter No. B/WL/NTCA/CR 13/2008-09 Dated 31-05-2008 for in principle approval of the Buffer Zone proposal under Section 38(O) of Wild life (Protection) Amendment Act, 2006 (39 of 2006). The due consultative process for obtaining the consent of the concerned Gram Sabhas of the villages lying in the limits of Buffer Zone has been gone through and the consent obtained.

The National Tiger Conservation Authority vide its letter No. 15-1/2009-NTCA (Part) dated 09-11-2009 conveyed its in principle approval, advising the

State Government to notify the Buffer Zone under Section 38 V of the Wild life (Protection) (Amendment) Act, 2006 (39 of 2006).

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 38 V 4 of Wild life (Protection) (Amendment) Act, 2006 (39 of 2006), the Government of Karnataka hereby declare the area with boundary fully described in the schedule to this notification as the "Buffer Zone" of the Bandipur Core or Critical Tiger Habitat with effect from the date of issue of this notification.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Boundary Description for the above forest areas is as described in the Govt. Notifications of respective forests.

North:- The line starts from North West corner of Karavadi Village of Bidarahalli Panchayath, H.D. Kote Taluk, Mysore District and runs along the Northern boundary till it reaches tri junction point of Singapatna, Kithur and Karawadi; then the line passes through Kithur and touches the tri junction point of Kithur, Uyyamball, Nadinathapura and Sagare; then the line runs along the southern boundary of Nandinathapura and touches south east corner of Nadinathapura; then the line passes through Sagare village and meets the tri junction point on the western most side of Hegganur; then the line passes all along the western boundary towards south and touches the tri junction point of Hegganur, Sagare and Telagumasahally; then the line passes all along the northern boundary of Telagumasahally and meets the tri junction point of Telagumasahally, Hegganur and Devalapura; then the line passes in Northern

direction along the western boundary of Devalapura and touches tri junction bondh of Hegganur, Mallarajapura and Devalapura; then the line passes all along the Northern boundary of Devalapura and touches tri junction bondh of Hullemala, Mallarajapura and Devalapura; then the line passes all along western boundary of Hullemala in North west direction and touches tri junction bondh of Masahally Mallarajapura and Hullemala; then the line passes on Northern boundary of Hullemala and touches the north east corner of Hullemala; then the line runs through Masahally village and touches a tri junction point of Sy. No. 20,19 and 11 of Beddalapura on the Western boundary of Beddalapura; then the line goes straight through Beddalapura and touches the tri junction bondh of Haleyur, Masahally and Beddalapura; then the line passes through Haleyur and touches a point on the tri junction bondh of Narasipura village, Haleyur village and Kothegala village; then the line passes all along the Western & Northern boundaries of Kothegala and touches the tri junction bondh on North east most corner of Kothegala and Puradakatte, Chikkadevammanabetta, Chamalapura and Halasur; then the line runs in south east direction all along the northern boundary of Halasur and touches the north east most corner of Halasur and then the line runs along the eastern boundary of Halasur in southern direction and touches the tri junction bondh of Chamalapura, Halasur and Jatagathipura and Mullur; then the line runs along northern boundary of Mullur and touches the tri junction bondh of Chamalapura, Mullur and Bennegere; then the line runs all along the Eastern boundary of Mullur and western boundary of Bennegere and Channagowdanahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Channagowdanahally, Mullur of H.D. Kote Taluk and Hediya of Nanjangud Taluk of Mysore district. Then the line runs along the common boundary of Hediya and Mullur and touches Hunsur-Begur Highway road; then the line runs all along the right side of the above side road passing through Hediya, Maduvinahally, Amakahally and Hosaveedu villages and touches the Western boundary of Devarayasettipura; then the line runs all along the western

boundary of Devarayasettipura and Kallahally and touches the tri junction point of Telana, Hadya and Channapatna; then the line runs all along the southern boundary of Channapatna and touches the tri junction point of Kallahally, Channapatna and Kellupura; then the line runs along the western and northern boundary of Kellepura of Gundlupet Taluk, Chamarajanagara District and touches the tri junction point of Channapatna, Mallahally and Kellupura; then the line runs along the western boundary of Mallahally and Kaladevanahally in Northern direction and touches the tri junction bondh of Hura, Kanthirayanapuradakaval and Kaladevanahally; then the line runs along the Northern boundary of Kaladevanahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Hosapura, Dyavegowdanapura, Kantharayanapuradakaval and Kaladevanahally; then the line runs all along the Northern boundary Hosapura and touches the tri junction bondh of Hosapura, Dyavegowdanapura and Yadavanahally; then the line runs in the same direction along the southern boundary of Dyavegowdanapura in southern direction and touches the tri junction bondh of Dyavegowdanapura Makanapura Nanjangud Taluk and Yadavanahally of Gundlupet taluk; then the line runs all along the Northern boundary of Yadavanahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Yadavanahally of Gundlupet Taluk and Krishnanapura of Nanjangud Taluk and Horiyala of Gundlupet Taluk; then the line runs in southern direction along the eastern boundary of Yadavanahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Horeyala, Yadavanahally and Kotekere village of Gundlupet Taluk; then the line runs in western direction along the southern boundary of Yadavanahally till it reaches the North west corner of Sy No. 20 of Kotekere; then the line runs in south ward direction along the western boundary of Kotekere and touches the South west corner of Sy No. 314 of Kotekere and State Highway road; then the line passes through Kotekere village in South-west direction and reaches the tri junction bondh of Kotekere, Bettadamahally and Manchally; then the line runs along the Eastern boundary of Manchahally till it reaches the tri junction


bondh of Manchally, Banagawadi, Savakanahally and Hasaguli; then the line runs in west ward direction along the southern boundary of Manchally and meets the tri junction point of Savakarahally, Banagavadi and Manchally; then the line runs along the eastern boundary of Savakanahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Devalapura, Bargi, Savakanahalli and Banagavadi; then the line runs in south ward direction along the eastern boundary of Bargi village till it reaches the tri junction bondh of Bargi, Mookahally and Masahally; then the line runs along the eastern boundary of Masahally till it reach tri junction bondh of Masahally, Beerambadi and Kannagala; the line runs along the eastern boundary of Beerambady and touches the tri junction bondh of Kannagala Beerambady and Lakkipura; then the line passes through the Kannagala village and joins the tri junction bondh of Kannagala, Kallipura and Honnegowdanahally villages; then the line runs along the Northern & Eastern boundary of Kallipura and joins the tri junction bondh of Hangala, Devarahally and Hangalahosally; then the line runs on southern and eastern boundary of Deverahally to meet the tri junction bondh Devarahally, Puthanapura and Hangala; then the line runs in the eastern and southern direction on the northern boundary of Hangala and touches the tri junction bondh of Hangala, Puthanapura and Hangalapura; then the line runs on the eastern boundary of Hangala and Siddanapura in south ward direction and touches the tri junction bondh of Pasainapura, Kalegowdanahally and Siddanapura; then the line runs in the eastward direction on the Northern boundary of Kaligowdanahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Pasainapura, Kaligowdanahally and Siddapura; then the line runs on Western & Northern boundary of Siddapura and touches the tri-junction bondh of North east corner of Siddapura and North west corner of Sy. No. 69 of Shivapura; then the line passes through Shivapura in straight line and touches the trijunction bondh of Hullepura, Hundipura and Shivapura; then the line runs on the Northern boundary of Hundipura and touches the tri junctions bondh of Hullepura, Belavady and Hundipura: then the line runs on

the eastern boundary of Hundipura in Southern direction and meet the tri junction bondh of Hullepura, Belavady and Hundipura and Kebbepura; then the line runs on the Northern boundary of Kebbepura and touches the north east corner Kebbepura and then the line passes through Belavady Village on the northern boundary of Sy. No. 35 & 36 of Belavady and touches the Western Boundary of Settahally; and then the line passes on the Western and Northern boundary Settahally and touches the tri junction bondh of Bommalapura Settahally and Bachahalli; then the line continues on the northern boundary of Settahally and Northern Boundary of Bachahally runs in Eastern direction and reaches the tri junction bondh of Malapura, Bachahally and Ankahally; then the line runs northward and touches the tri junction bondh of Ankahally, Kadasoge and Yariur; then the line runs in the east and south east direction all along the boundary of Yeriur and touches the tri junction bondh of Yeriur, Heggavadi and the Daribegur; then the line runs south ward on the western boundary of Heggavadi till it reaches the North West corner of Sy No. 256 of Heggavadi and then the line passes through Heggavadi village and touches the North east corner of Sy. No. 362 of Heggavadi; then the line runs along the Northern boundary of Kundakere in North East direction and touches the tri junction bondh of Heggavady, Kundakere and Chirakanahally; then the line traverse in north west direction of the western boundary of Chirakanahally and reaches the tri junction bondh of Vaddagere, Chirakanahally and Heggavadi; then the line runs in north east direction and reaches the tri junction bondh of Vaddagere, Chirakanahally and Bommanahally; then the line traverses along the northern boundary of Chirakanahally and Kadabur and reaches the tri junction bondh of Kadabur Ramaianappura and Kengavadi; then the line traverses along the western & northern boundary of Ramaianapura; then the line traverses through Yaraganahally and on the northern boundary of Shindanapura , Yonagumba and Voddarahally of Chamarajanagara Taluk and District and touches Tamil Nadu State boundary.

East:- Then the line traverses along the eastern boundary of Vaddarahally, Yonagumba and Yerahally of Chamarajanagara Taluk and touches the north east boundary of Moyar State Forest and also the Bandipur Tiger Reserve.

South & West:- Then the line traverses all along the Northern boundary of the Bandipur Tiger Reserve; then it touches the HFL of Kabini Back water; then all along the Kabini back water HFL Limits it reaches the starting point.
